 1. Light your yard and house if you are returning from an evening of shopping. Leave lights on outside and make sure the path from your driveway to your door is well lit.
 2. Do not try to unload all your packages at once. The criminals will see what you have. Remember to make small trips back and fourth to the house. Also you are more vulnerable when your hands and arms are full.
 3. Leave your purse in your trunk but keep your keys, cell phone and a small wallet on your persons in your pockets. If they get your purse the wont get your keys, cell phone and your wallet.
 4. Do not get out of the car with your back to the street. Before you get out, look around and see what is going on and look for unfamiliar people near you or your house. Be observant to what is going out.While at the Stores:
 1. Make small frequent trips back to your car to unload goods.
 2. Please your purse and shopping in your trunk. Do not leave your purse under the seat in the car.
 3. Park in a well lit area.
 4. If you don't feel good leaving a store after closing ask the security officer to escort you to your car.
