To Whom It May Concern,

The Cradock Civic League voted Tuesday, December 7, 2010 at its regularly scheduled meeting to pass the following motion: *"The Cradock Civic League shall write a letter of support for the residents of Parkside Place stating that it supports the Park Side Place Residents' request made to the City of Portsmouth to have a residential restrictive parking zone on the residential service drive side (the side of the Parkside Place street that serves residential parking driveways) and to be designated with signs as Resident Parking Only"*.

The Cradock Civic League believes that the residential restrictive parking zone will address the problems that arise when the residential street Parkside Place is used for the parking of motor vehicles by persons using the adjacent George Washington Park and who do not reside in the neighborhood. The establishment of resident-parking-only zones would reduce these problems, which include, but are not limited to, hazardous traffic conditions, air and noise pollution, litter, and inability of residents of these neighborhoods to obtain easy access to and adequate parking near their residences.

We are all in this together and the Cradock Civic League is working hard to make sure we meet the needs and address all the concerns of all of our residents. The Cradock Civic Leagues goal is to make sure that everyone can enjoy George Washington Park safely and securely and that Parkside Place street is safe for the Residents and George Washington Park visitors
