- Cradock High School Unscheduled Meeting Review. Motion Passed on August 4th – *“Proposed development of the Old Cradock High school Property with the provision the City of Portsmouth, Portsmouth Redevelopment Housing Authority and developers that the recreational facility be provided for the community and within a reasonable timeline.” 16 for 2 opposed.*

New Business:

- Community Day September 11, 2010 at 11-3. Sponsor the Popcorn.
Option 1: 400 servings = \$70.00 +\$24.00 = \$94.00 (\$47.00) Option 2: 500 servings = \$87.50 +\$30.00 = \$117.50 (\$58.75). Split 50% with Cradock Neighborhood Watch.
- New motion to hold the Portsmouth City Council and PRHA responsible for providing an up and running operational Recreation Center Facility before the demolition of the Cradock Rec. Center from the construction of the new housing development . Also the establishment of a design team to work with the developers of the Old Cradock High School property to make sure that the construction of the new development does not create undue hardship for the West Cradock Community and South Eastern Portsmouth Community.
